Dear Village Resident

With the recent announcements which come into force today, we wanted to send a short newsletter out to everyone.

From today, 5th November until Wednesday 2nd December the Government has approved a national lockdown and we must reduce our contact with other people.

The advice is to stay at home except for specific purposes such as medical appointments and food shopping. Essential shops and businesses will remain open. You can take exercise outdoors with your household or one other person. In summary:

1. Stay at home, except for specific purposes.
2. Avoid meeting people you do not live with, except for specific purposes.
3. Non-essential businesses and venues will be closed.

These new measures will reduce the growth rate of the virus, which will:

- prevent the NHS from being overwhelmed
- ensure schools, colleges and universities can stay open
- ensure that as many people as possible can continue to work
